

Series 4, Guest Books, 1893-1922

Extent: Fifteen guest books, 1 box of enclosures, (111 items), 39 oversized items

The series comprises guest books kept by Isabella Stewart Gardner in Boston, Brookline, and Venice, Italy. The guest books were filled in by friends, family, and guests, including signatures, dates, locations, poems, jokes, illustrations, and musical notations. The books are illustrated with photographs, newspaper clippings, and ephemera; some volumes contain correspondence pasted directly to the pages. The guest books were shelved in the Vaticino until the late 1960's; they are arranged in chronological order.

The books are fully digitized and available via the online collection. An index of signers is available, as are transcriptions of several books. Transcriptions of letters pasted into the guestbooks are also available.

Items removed from the book are listed beneath each entry, arranged in book-page order. Before the books were paginated, enclosures were listed by the first signer's name and date on the page the item was removed from. This previous practice caused some confusion in legacy inventories. All entries have been corrected to include the associated page number. If the item's placement in the book is unknown, it is at the end of the enclosure list.
